

MURNI'S BODY PASSION

I Gusti Ayu Kadek Murniasih (1966 – 2006)

"Murni loves her body more than her art. Van Gogh loves his art more than his body," exclaimed Ida Bagus Punia1, a fellow artist in Jembrana, West Bali: Murni's birth place.

Her recent elevation to the Global Art pantheon is a testament to her ability to win the hearts of world museum curators and collectors alike, and is a source of pride for Indonesia, and especially the Balinese. Bali once again reaches the pinnacle of the Global Art community.

Murni is the prodigal daughter of Balinese painting tradition. Mokoh was her teacher, who unlocked her talent. Mokoh's soft and subtle colors were transformed to reflect her character, as the daughter of Jembrana, into bold and cheerful Fauvist colors.

She was a prolific artist who started painting at 14, but also worked with various media: including life size dolls (drawn from her experience working as a seamstress), large wooden carvings and wire statues that she designed and supervised from her death bed.

For her, body parts served as a novel vocabulary in an artistic language that she solely created: human bodies and body parts that she linked together into artistic visual phrases, paragraphs and ultimately, the story of her own life journey. Thus, the body of her works is a visual journal of her daily life, aspirations and dreams. In her short life, she was cheerful and full of laughter, despite her traumatic life history2. She chose to be a Victor rather than a Victim. Her art is joyous, purposeful and rebellious...that's Murni!






THE NEW ART TEACHER SERIES

NON-TECHNICAL SKILLS: GESTURES AND WATERCOLOUR | 2024 60 CM X 80 CM MIXED MEDIA












In my Tenun series of works, I am inspired by the rich Culture tradition of textile, The Tenun of Indonesia. I am exploring the varied techniques and the feelings underlying the highly skilled making of the weaves. I find inspiration in the surface textures and use of fractal design, colours, gold threads and skills.

I am searching for the feeling and emotional connection, creating paintings that pay homage to the skill and dedication of so many craftswomen and men.

The use of gold and silver leaf in my work represents the luminous qualities of the threads and colours. The original use of textures and glazing techniques enhance the wonderful aesthetic character of my Tenun series.



NATURE SERIES

In my Nature series of works, I draw inspiration from the captivating beauty of the natural world, delving into the fractal elements of flowers, trees, and other aspect of nature.

These paintings are akin to portraits that deep dive into the subject and character of motif.

The pattern and geometry we observe in nature continually fascinate me. I employ silver and gold leaf to create a unique fusion of materials and textures.

By illuminating parts of the canvas, which change with the viewing angle and lighting, I add layers of depth, intrigue and feeling to the paintings.

IG Sukarya's works are inspired by everyday life, traditional customs and culture.

In his exploratory studies, he discovered a Balinese cultural heritage called Tatah Art, an ancient art that can be found in barong, rangda and wayang clothing.

From the findings of his exploration, I.G Sukarya chose to use cowhide, as a medium that is linked to the regeneration of the development of images from carving (Tatah) art which was initially intended for direct usage/commission work to become fine art.

Inheriting the carving technique always depicts a hedonistic form full of Balinese ornaments. In the eyes of I.G Sukarya, this is a form that is simpler and closer to today's reality. So that every detail of his work provides room for imagination for the viewer to pay more attention to how his work can form imaginary illusions and experiences of the viewer.




